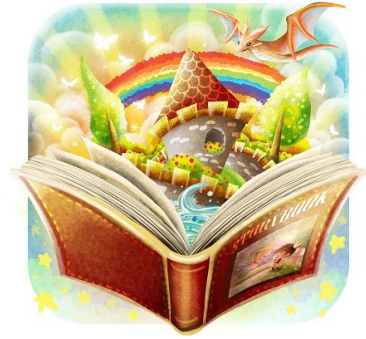

He teaches scholastic chess programs in Acton, Wellesley, Shrewsbury, Weston, Sudbury, Framingham, Concord, and Southborough. Lou has coached numerous Massachusetts players and teams at National Scholastic Championships in Orlando, Pittsburgh, Chicago, Nashville, Louisville, Atlanta and Dallas. His students have won State Scholastic Singles Championships and a National Championship. Lou is a writer and publisher of theoretical opening articles, chess publications, and is a reviewer for Chess Horizons.

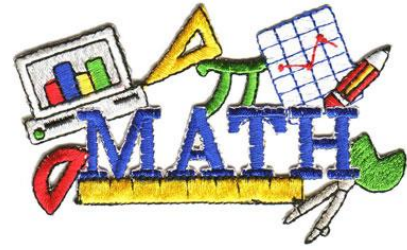
