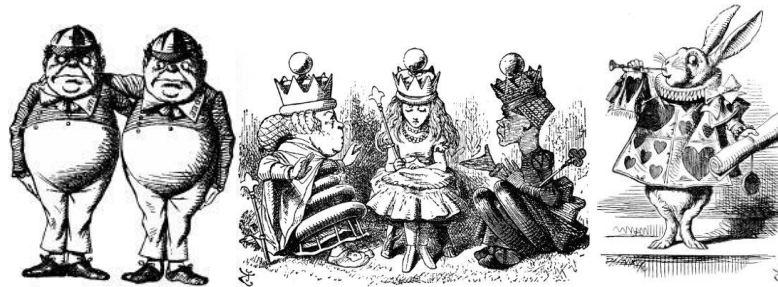

This exciting program is an intensive immersion into the realm of primitive technology and survival skills! Included will be a wide array of hands-on ancestral wisdom using Earth as our teacher and guide at the Cobb Memorial Woods and land around the school.

Some of the skills and activities may include but are not limited to: Fire making (including friction methods and flint and steel), debris shelter building, cordage, wild edibles/ethnobotany, water (finding and treating), containers of clay, birch bark, gourds and coal burned spoons, navigation, primitive cooking, tool making, bone whistles, coyote teaching, track and animal signs, artifacts, solo vision quest, fishing, natural dyeing, paint pigment making, simulated archaeological dig, survival kits, BOB bags, flintknapping, etc.

Games, stories, drama, songs, cooking, discovery hikes and skill development will all be part of the primitive living, odyssey.
