Tuition Assistance

Frequently Asked Questions



Who:

- Families with students in CH3 older **or** any family with two or more children attending any program level at Oak Meadow.
- In the 2024-25 school year, 29% of OMS students received a tuition assistance grant.
- Tuition assistance is need-based. Most families who apply for tuition assistance receive some level of assistance.

What:

- In the 2023-24 school year, the average award was \$6,965.
- Awards very rarely exceed 50% of tuition.
- OMS seeks to award as many grants as the budget allows for a given academic year.

Where:

- Apply online through <u>FACTS</u>. Returning families use the same login credentials they use for tuition management.

When:

- Returning families should submit applications by Feb. 15.
- New families should submit by March 10.
- Families must reapply each school year. Eligibility is reviewed annually.
