Billing and Cancellation Policies

Early Bird Discount: Submit your **registration by Friday, March 27, 2026**, to receive a \$50 discount per week (applicable for full weeks only).

Sibling Discount: When siblings are registered for a total of 10 weeks or more, families receive a one-time, \$300 discount, which gets applied at the end of the summer.

Deposit: A \$150/week nonrefundable, nontransferable deposit will be billed to your FACTS account **the week of March 30**. This deposit will be deducted from your remaining Summer Program tuition.

The summer program is billed bi-weekly throughout the summer. No refund or tuition reduction will be provided for children who arrive late, leave early, or attend only part of the program for any reason.

Every Friday is Pizza and Popsicle Day! Permission must be acknowledged on the registration form. *The cost is included.*

Aftercare Billing

- Summer aftercare is billed monthly.
- Families will be charged for the specific days their student attends aftercare.

Private Music Lessons Billing

- Private music lessons will be billed at the end of the summer.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be submitted in writing to the Director of Auxiliary Programs, **Antonella Fuchser**, at afuchser@oakmeadow.org at least **three weeks prior to the program's start date**.
- Cancellations received within 21 days of a program's start date will be billed in full. However, registration may be transferred to another program week based on availability.
- Exceptions will be made only with a valid doctor's note. A standard **minimum cancellation fee of \$50** will apply if the cancellation is accepted.
- Programs canceled by Oak Meadow due to low enrollment will be announced by **May 1, 2026**.
